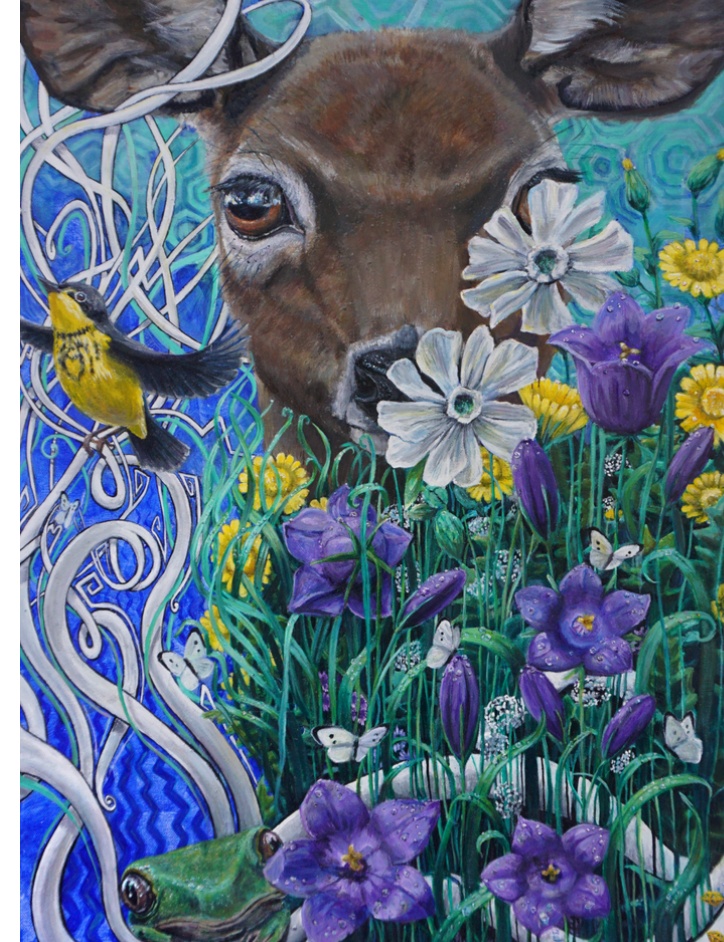

We reached nearly 1,200 people through our free programming such as Open Studio, Take Home Art Kits, and other outreach activities.
